**SENOKO POWER BECOMES FIRST ENERGY COMPANY TO RECEIVE
SINGAPORE GREEN PLAN 2012 AWARD**

Singapore, 28 October 2005 – Senoko Power Limited, the leader in greenhouse gas emissions reduction and educating the young on climate change, today became the first local energy company to receive the Singapore Green Plan (SGP) 2012 Award.

At a ceremony held at the National Library, Mr Roy Adair, President & CEO of Senoko Power, accepted the prestigious national award from Dr Yaacob Ibrahim, Minister for Environment & Water Resources.

The SGP 2012 Award recognises outstanding organisations and companies that are role models of environmental protection and have contributed significantly to Singapore's efforts to achieve environmental sustainability and attain the targets set out in the SGP 2012. The SGP 2012 constitutes Singapore's blueprint for environmental sustainability.

Senoko Power, Singapore's largest power generator and electricity retailer, is focused on meeting the increasingly discerning needs of its customers in providing electricity that is safe, reliable, competitively priced and environmentally friendly.

Integrating the Singapore Green Plan 2012 into its business decisions and processes, Senoko Power has achieved a 40% reduction in annual carbon intensity. The Company's recently completed repowering project dramatically reduced CO₂ emissions by 2.5 million tonnes per annum while increasing generation capacity and efficiency. Senoko Power produces approximately 32% of Singapore's electricity needs with well over 90% of its power coming from cleaner, gas-fired combined cycle plants. Senoko Power also continues to explore the use of clean energy sources which will increase competitiveness, enhance reliability, expand fuel supply choice and improve our environment.

As a genuine triple bottom line company, Senoko Power is actively involved in environmental initiatives with schools, the community and the business sector. Senoko's National Weather Study initiative, launched in March 2005, raises awareness among students from the 170 participating schools, from the primary level to junior college level of the issue of climate change. By engaging them in interesting and learning-by-doing projects, students are encouraged to think globally and act locally in protecting our environment.

Senoko Power's innovative, environmentally friendly and customer focused approach to electricity production enables it to "provide the power to make a difference" for all Singaporeans.

Mr Roy Adair said, "Senoko Power is honoured to receive the SGP2012 Award. It has always been Senoko Power's vision to be a socially responsible corporate citizen and good neighbour who cares about the impact of our work on the environment we live in. "
