

Competition Rules & Regulations



Basic Rules

- Apply to all participating teams competing on projects related to climate change.
- Any team found to breach any of the rules & regulations will be disqualified & immediately eliminated from competition.
- Decision of panel of judges is final.



Rules & Regulations

- Submission may be in the form of projects, essays, drawings, video recording, exhibits, and/or artworks.
- 1st prize winners with overseas travel apply to 'project' submission only.
- Project competition is open only to students from primary schools, secondary schools and junior colleges for 2006.



Rules & Regulations

- Participating team must register to participate by submitting a completed Project Submission Form by November 2005.
- Submitted project should neither have won awards in any competition nor have been submitted concurrently to other similar competitions.
- A school may enter more than one team.
- The maximum number of members in a team is six (6) persons including the mentor-teacher.



Rules & Regulations

- Team members may come from different classes and ages within the same school.
- A team member may compete in more than one team.
- Project proposals, targets, scope and methodologies should be unique. Any form of plagiarism will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Senoko will own the copyright of each completed project.
- Reference materials or assistance from non team members should be declared & acknowledged.



Rules & Regulations

- Students may share ideas and seek advice from friends, teachers or parents, but **NOT** from paid consultant.
- Project work must be submitted by 31 March 2006.
- Team must abide by the time & schedule given by the evaluating judges.
- All teams will be evaluated & judged utilising the Judging Criteria.
