

ISO 14001 Environmental Management System (EMS)

Our environmental management system covers policy, commitment, evaluation, review and improvement of environmental performance. Senoko Power is the first generation company to be awarded ISO 14001 certification. Under ISO 14001, environmental objectives and targets within the framework of an environmental policy statement are audited both internally and externally every half-year.

In addition to local regulatory requirements, corporate environmental objectives are defined. These range from overall corporate objectives on emissions reduction through to corporately-sponsored initiatives such as sponsorship for worthy community-based environmental awareness projects and a company-wide system for the dissemination of environmental information. These corporate targets are incorporated into the Annual Business Plan, reviewed by the Board, progress reported monthly, and new targets added as necessary.

EHS audit inspection was conducted monthly by independent party. The independent auditors were given access to make surprised inspection. The audit emphasised safety & environmental compliance, and elimination of any potential mosquito breeding grounds. We are glad to report that the auditors had found consistent compliance in EHS regulation, continual improvement in site condition and greater awareness among the employees.

In addition, there was 6-monthly surveillance audit by PSB. Their audits again consistently gave a full bill of confidence of Senoko EHS management systems. The auditors highlighted Senoko active involvement in both the environment and community circles. The recognition was testimonial of the company's vision and its collective team work.
